COVID-19/ VACCINES AND OTHER

COVID-19 and Monkeypox *SSHA Updates to COVID-19 Directives*

- As of March 15th 2023, SSHA has updated Directive 2020-01 and 2020-02. These changes include updates to the use of protective eyewear, and screening procedures:
- 1) Updates to protective eyewear

• Removing the requirement to wear daily eye protection, except when: -Providing direct care to clients who are suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19 or in a suspected or declared COVID-19 outbreak

-Performing Aerosol Generating Medical Procedures

- 2) Updates to screening procedures
 - Removing active daily screening requirements (for staff, clients, visitors), but continuing for:

-All new clients and clients transferred from other sites. All new and transferred clients should continue to be actively screened using the <u>COVID-19 Client Screening Tool for</u> <u>Homelessness Service Settings</u> upon admission or intake.

Scheduling Vaccine Clinics

- Moderna and Pfizer bivalent COVID-19 vaccines continue to be available for shelter clients and staff (18 years or older for Moderna, and 12 years or older for Pfizer), as a booster dose for people who have completed their primary COVID-19 vaccine series. <u>Click here for more information regarding vaccine eligibility.</u>

Current Vaccination Status at Reporting Shelter Locations:

All programs:

- 79% have received first dose!
- 70% are fully vaccinated!
- POS Shelters are at 73% vaccinated!
- DOS shelters are at 81% vaccinated!

Youth programs:

- 76% have received their first dose!
- 68% are fully vaccinated!
