COVID-19 AND VACCINES

- SSHA has increased capacity at the COVID-19 Isolation and Recovery Site. Staff should continue to refer <u>eligible clients</u>. Electronic referrals can be made <u>HERE</u>. Clients with positive rapid antigen tests can be referred to the site.
- Service providers who require additional PPE for staff or clients should contact their Agency Review Officer.
- Organizations are also able to order PPE and Rapid Antigen Tests through the provincial portal: <u>Critical Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Intake</u> <u>Form | Ontario Health (ehealthontario.on.ca)</u>
- SSHA will be will be decommissioning the 24-hour respite site at Masaryk-Cowan Community Centre starting the week of February 28, with all clients relocated by March 3. New admissions to the site will stop prior to February 28th.
- Although temporary, Warden Hilltop Community Centre will continue to operate as a 24-hour respite site. The need for this program will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.

ICHA VIRTUAL CLINIC SUPPORT

- Inner City Health Associates (ICHA) will be offering virtual clinical support to shelters for residents who are isolating in-situ under direction of Toronto Public Health as a result of a shelter outbreak.
- This aim of this program is to support residents with non-urgent health care concerns during their in-situ isolation. This will operate like a virtual walk-in clinic, with the demand being driven by the shelter provider based on an identified resident/client needs.
- This program will run Monday- Friday from 9am-5pm. Nurses will return referral requests based on the order they are received. Please allow for a 30-60 minute grace period to receive a return call.

COVID-19 TRANSITION PLAN
