COVID-19 AND VACCINES

- SSHA is increasing capacity at the COVID-19 Recovery and Isolation Site. Service providers are encouraged to refer clients to the Isolation and Recovery Centre when positive clients test positive as there is continuous flow in and out of the recovery centre. Click **HERE** to access the online referral form
- People experiencing homelessness and staff working in shelters continue to be eligible for PCR testing.
- Positive results from rapid antigen test should be considered confirmed cases and can be referred to the Recovery and Isolation Site.
- TPH developed a poster in response to the increasing resistance to getting the Moderna Vaccine for the booster shot. Click **HERE** to view the poster.
- East Toronto Health Partners (ETHP) continues to offer testing and will add new testing dates once available. Please check the website regularly for updates <u>HERE</u>.
- The University Health Network (700 Bay St location) has reduced their mask fitting services to one day per week. Appointments can be booked **HERE.**
- Service providers who have not received their PPE delivery of N95s for clients or require additional PPE for staff or clients should contact their Agency Review Officer.
- SSHA orders supplies of N95 masks every week and the delivery window dates for the month of February are as follows: Feb 4-7, Feb 11-14, and Feb 18-21. If your program currently has an oversupply and feel that your program has enough supply of N95 masks until February 14th, please connect with SSHA and the order can be paused and resumed the week after as needed.

CAMPAIGN VACCINATION TORONTO

TSN is currently still expanding its pool of Peer Champions beyond priority shelter sites (i.e., sites with less than 50% vaccine uptake rate).
