COVID-19 AND VACCINES

- SSHA has updated *Directive 2020-02 Universal Masking* which Includes the requirement for all clients and visitors to use a medical mask and Includes the use of N95 respirators for staff.
- SSHA has procured approximately 110,000 N95 respirators for staff use and PPE deliveries to all homelessness service settings have commenced.
- Please click **HERE** for more information on the directive on mandatory masks for clients and required PPE for staff.
- PPE deliveries to service providers have begun, with priority for those in outbreak. All sites should receive their PPE shipment which includes and initial delivery of rapid antigen tests for staff by Monday January 3, 2022.
