COVID-19/ VACCINES AND OTHER

Vaccinations:

- On July 14th 2022, Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health announced the expansion of eligibility for the second COVID-19 vaccine booster dose (fourth dose) to all adults.
- Those between the ages of 18 and 59 years old who have had their first booster shot at least five months ago will be able to book an appointment to get their second booster dose. (It must also be at least three months since a COVID-19 infection) To book an appointment please click <u>HERE</u>
- This expansion of eligibility is aimed at adults who have underlying health issues and are at higher risk of severe infection.

- Current provincial guidelines indicate that a positive result from a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) does not require confirmation through PCR testing at a COVID-19 Assessment Centre.

 Masking Requirements still in effect for shelters
- To protect the health and safety of staff and clients, the City has decided to continue mandatory masking for shelters, 24-hour respite and 24-hour women's drop-in sites, as outlined in the Directive on masks and personal protective equipment use can be found **HERE.**

- 67% are fully vaccinated!
